AH discussed the Mere and he explained the plans of the village committee towards the mere. AH said that Paul Storer has said that he will donate a day working on the tree's at the mere. Paul has also spoken to a gentleman from Peak Park and is in discussions.

AH then discussed point 1 of correspondence. Abbots Cottage planning was granted, Fernydale granted, Quiet woman granted, the group agreed to no objections and the Methodist Chapel was denied.

AH informed the group that finance has gone up to £2300 from £1800 last year, and all Councillors were in agreement to leave it at £2300 again for 2025/26, due to increased monies required from different group such as the church.

AH delivered his chairs report. AH said he had nothing to report except that the church has had some volunteers who have cut the trees back in the church and that it is looking really good AH gave a special thanks to Paul and Brandon Heywood for all of their hard work on the day.

PB said she would like to look into getting one of the metal plaques for the village. PB will look into costings.
